These will align with and augment the services currently provided at Stirling Community Hospital Forth Valley College will also provide vocational training at the facility with the additional opportunity to provide other services such as catering.

Key facts	The Care Village project is viewed as an exciting and innovative project. The proposals, which have been developed as part of joint partnership between NHS Forth Valley and Stirling Council, would transform the way services are delivered to older people by bringing a wide range of health, social care, training and GP services together on one site.
