Departmental information	The project comprised the development of a single integrated dental treatment and training centre for the population of Perth & Kinross which would include provision of 20 surgeries covering GDS, CDS, vocational training, outreach training and clinical skills room as well as a local decontamination unit which was required to meet the recommendations of the Glennie Report. The new facility was completed in September 2010 and the new service saw its first patients on 23 rd November 2010. Equipment included 20 dental chairs, decontamination suite, x-ray machines, phantom heads.
